

# Religious Education Schedule – 2017-2018

Grades Pre-K through 8 will meet at Lebanon Elementary School. Grade 9 will meet in the Church.

All classes begin promptly at 9:00 a.m. and will end at 10:00 a.m.

Parents will be required to pick up their children in their classrooms – not in the parking lot. We need to assure that children leave with only the designated contact you have indicated on their registration forms.

# 2017-2018 CCD Project

Dear Parents and Parishioners,

This year our CCD project is again to help the people of Haiti with the "Give-a-Goat" program.

The cost of one pregnant goat is \$ 150. The goats bring self-sufficiency and hope to a family trapped in poverty. Recipients can breed their goats and sell or barter the offspring, providing some income as well as animal protein.

Our children are able to name the goats that are donated. We will receive a photo of the goat, with it's name and family receiving the goat.

We have participated in this project for a few years now and the children really enjoy it. It will be a great way for our kids to help those in Haiti.

Last year we raised over \$ 3,150 for our efforts...a total of 21 goats. I would like to set our goal this year for 22 goats or \$ 3,300.

Each class will have a donation jar and children should bring whatever they can each Sunday. There will also be a donation jar in Church.

I ask that you support this Corporal Act of Mercy to feed the hungry and to help those who are not as fortunate as we are.
